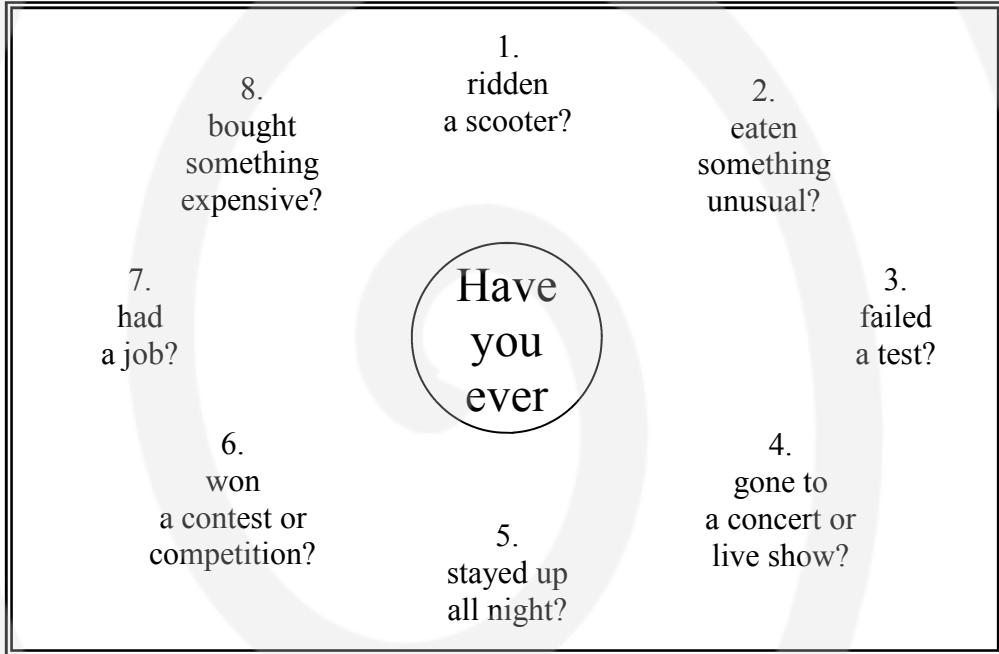
1a. 中央の1 - 8の疑問文とA - Hの答えを一致させましょう。
