
## 14 - Shawn had been working for three hours when the earthquake hit.

## 昨日起きた地震に関する会話を読みましょう。

Shawn: What were you doing yesterday when the earthquake hit?

Sylvia: I was studying in the library. How about you?

Shawn: I was working.




上記のSylviaとShawnの会話では過去進行形(was/were ~ing)に重点を置き、突然起きた動作(the earthquake <u>hit</u>)によって妨げられている動作(studying / working)を表しています。そして、継続したり長い時間かかる動作と突然起きる動作の多くは"I was studying/working <u>when</u> the earthquake hit."のように<u>when</u>でつながり、両方の動作は過去の出来事に当たります。

従って、地震が起こったときにSylviaとShawnが行っていたことを過去進行形を 用いて表すことができるのです。

しかし、過去進行形ではSylviaが $\underline{\textit{Eoc}}$ らい勉強し、Shawnが $\underline{\textit{Eoc}}$ らい働いていたのかという動作の長さを表すことはできません。例えば、"I was studying/working for 2 hours when the earthquake hit." という表現は相手に不自然な印象を与えることからネイティブスピーカーは用いません。もし動作の長さを表したければ、過去完了進行形を使う必要があるのです。

1. Sylvia had been studying for two hours when the earthquake hit.



2. Shawn <u>had been</u> work<u>ing for three hours</u> when the earthquake hit.

上記のとおり、過去進行形(I was working when the earthquake hit) と過去完了進行形(I had been working for three hours when the earthquake hit) は基本的には同じこと(時間がより長くかかる動作が突然起きた動作に妨げられた)を意味します。そして両方の動作が過去の出来事に当たります。唯一の違いは過去完了進行形では突然あることが起きたとき(when the earthquake hit)にどのくらい長くずっと働いたり、仕事をしていたのか表せる点にあります。
