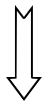
1. すでに決定している場合 *'be + going to'* を使用する:

I'm going to meet a friend for dinner tonight.

すでに決定していて、より確実性が高いことを言う場合には *'be + ~ing'* を使用する:

I'm taking a trip to Hokkaido next week.

未決定の場合は *'will'* を使用する。'will' は、下記の単語と一緒に使用する機会が多い。



***maybe, guess*** (~50%)  
***think, probably*** (~75%)

下の例文は全て はっきりしていない 場合の用法である。



Maybe I'll call you tomorrow. (はっきりしていない)



I guess I'll study a little. (はっきりしていない)



I think I'll have pasta for dinner tonight. (はっきりしていない)



I'll probably buy a new computer. (はっきりしていない)

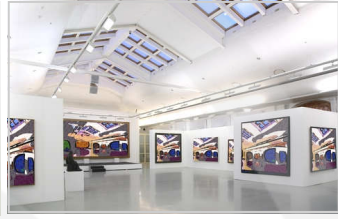
Hiroshi — Hey Jim, what are you doing on Saturday?
