





(Tell the students to stay on page 100 and look at the six pictures. Write on the board: 'It's _____. Our key words are...'. You read out stories 1 - 6 and in pairs, the students listen and choose the correct name, giving you the key words that helped them to decide. The key words have been double underlined.)

"Have you ever...?" doesn't need such a point in time. It refers to your entire life. Do numbers 1 and 2 first, then check in pairs and as a class. Do the same for numbers 3 and 4, then 5 and 6. Ask some or all of the oral comprehension questions. Give starting hints when necessary.)
