


1. 下のKeikoのアメリカでの生活を読み、彼女が撮った写真を見てみましょう。


(Next, have the students look at the pictures Keiko took. Ask the following oral comprehension questions. All the answers should start with "She..")

5. What instrument did she play?
6. What did she do after school?
7. What did she watch on TV?
8. What time did she go to bed?
9. How was her health?



(Go over the diagram. Explain that 'used to' means something you did before but don't do anymore. Give other examples such as, "I used to have long hair, but now it's short," "I used to listen to heavy metal, but I don't anymore...")

(Next, have the students fill in the blanks. Do numbers 1 and 2 as a class to get them started. Give time limits. Check in pairs and as a class. Then, the students can practice - S1 = "Now I play tennis," S2 = "...but when I was in junior high school, I used to play volleyball" - at random.)

(Have the students go back to page 114. Tell them that they're going to hear a conversation between John and Chieko. Dictate the questions, guess some possible answers, read out the conversation twice and have the students answer. Check in pairs and as a class. Then, do a listen and repeat (the students should not be looking at the conversation). Finally, have the students read the conversation silently and in pairs with eye contact.)

4. Conversation:

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1. What sports did Chieko use to play?
2. What about John?
3. What did Chieko use to have?
